
## Need help with accommodation?

# **CONTEST CORNER**

A big CONGRATULATIONS to those quartets who qualified to compete in our National Quartet Contest in Christchurch. You will find some information below regarding the Traffic Pattern for that contest.

DON'T FORGET TO ENTER YOUR CHORUS OR QUARTET IN THE APPROPRIATE CONTEST – ENTRIES CLOSE 16 JULY – refer email to Presidents and Directors dated 21/06/2019 from John Faris for all chorus entry details.

If your quartet didn't make the cut this year, why not come to Convention with the view to taking every opportunity you can to "sing around". Sing at the Afterglows if the opportunity arises, sing on the street corners between events, sing a song over dinner – participate in spreading the word about this wonderful art form we are all involved in. Be on the lookout for opportunities to sing or see if there is an event you could sing at - no guarantees a spot will be available but it would be nice to offer your services to the Convention (through the CPG) if you feel your quartet is worthy of participation and missed out!

Missing the cut also provides the opportunity for you to hear all the other performances so why not sit and listen to the contest with a view to working out why each quartet might have scored higher than yours? Figure out what your ensemble needs to do and set your sights now, on next year!

## Traffic Pattern Information

# Quartets

The Isaac Theatre Royal (ITR) is set up very well with backstage facilities for a quartet contest. You will enter the Traffic Pattern at the backstage entrance (all specific directions will be given out at a later date) and 25 minutes later you will be on stage performing your set. As part of the Traffic pattern you will have 15 minutes in a warm up room where you can sing and prepare for your performance. There are toilet facilities in each of the warm up rooms. This area is very compact so not a lot of ground to cover from beginning to end. Photography plan has not been determined as yet, so you will be advised on that opportunity nearer the time.

## Choruses

Unfortunately the backstage area in the ITR does not provide for a suitable warm up room for the choruses, so we will be adding the Gloucester Room into the Traffic Pattern as the one and only warm up room for the choruses. There will be a set of risers available in this room. Only having one room available where it is possible to sing limits the warm up time for each chorus, so depending on the efficiency of choruses entering and exiting, you will have around 9 mins singing time at the beginning of the pattern. From there, you will be guided out the front of the theatre and down the side alley to the backstage door. There will be toilet facilities available in this backstage area. You will have a few minutes in the Green Room to reassemble prior to heading to the stage. The Traffic Pattern will take just over 30 minutes from check in to on stage time.


