## Looking for Accommodation?


Ken Francis [kenf@maxnet.co.nz] has done a lot of leg work identifying a range of accommodation options and pricing.

# Quartet Registration and Contest Dates

## Quartet Registration

Now is the time for quartets to get organised for regional contests.

Quartet registration/re-registration has to be completed annually. To do this, please e-mail me your details.

To register or renew your quartet with BHNZ and to enter the quartet in a contest, all quartet members must be current financial members of BHNZ. Please check with your chapter director/membership officer/webmaster regarding membership renewal.

If you are a Member-at-Large you will need to complete a Member-at-Large renewal, or if you are new please fill out an application form.

#### Contest Dates

The Regional Contest dates are:

22nd March 2019 BHNZ South (Christchurch)

29th March 2019 BHNZ North (Waikanae)

Registration for BHNZ South and North is now open. As well as making arrangements to go to a contest with the contest organisers, a quartet needs to enter that contest through the contest website: http://contests.barbershop.org.au. Only a member of the quartet can enter and they need to be a user on the website. To be a user, you will need to have your BHNZ Member ID and the email address recorded with your membership. If you don't know these, check with your chapter.

If your quartet is unable to attend a contest in person, you are able to submit a video recording for assessment. The closing date for entries for video assessment is 31 May 2019. Entries must be made through the contest website as above and then the details sent to the C & J Committee. If you are entering a video recording for assessment, please contact me ASAP regarding the guidelines?

The minimum "pass" score for nationals is 55 but there is a limit of 20 quartets that can compete. After the last regional (which is the video contest), the C & J Committee will announce which quartets have actually qualified.

### A reminder for the National Contest:

### For Quartets

- 1. The Isaac Theatre Royal has a normal theatre stage set up
- 2. The Traffic Pattern will all be backstage so no long distances to walk
- 3. You will enter Stage Left and exit Stage Right as in Tauranga.

#### For Choruses

- 1. The Isaac Theatre Royal has a normal theatre stage set up
- 2. The backstage area has adequate warm ups rooms so the Traffic Pattern will all be back stage
- 3. We will be using a curtain, so you will be able to load the risers out of view of the audience.
- 4. Enter Stage Left, exit Stage Right.

The BHNZ Contest Rules have been revised and promulgated so make sure you take a look at those and note any important changes.

Michael Markham's email of 8 Feb 19 provided a copy of the updated rules along with the following details:

Amendments include an emphasis for quartets to qualify for the national contest at our upcoming regional contests that are held in conjunction with the HEA weekends in Christchurch and Wellington in March. Please note that it is not mandatory that you are registered for HEA to compete at the contest (which will be held on the Friday night of both HEAs).

The contests will include a full panel of judges, with scores and evaluations just as you would have at the national contest, so we are really excited to be able to provide you with another contest opportunity during the year and a chance to get live feedback from the judges.

If you are unable to make the regional contests there is a backup option of a video qualification, but I would encourage you to use this as a last resort.

Detailed video qualification instructions will come out to you following the regional contests.

To date I have not received advice from any chorus that they are NOT going to compete, so it looks like we might have a full house. That makes for a great contest!
