I'm Carl McGregor, the new Chair of the 2025 Barbershop Harmony New Zealand ("BHNZ") Convention.

I am saddened to say that Lynn Humphrey, our Convention Chairman, passed away on Thursday, 3rd of July, 3 weeks after being diagnosed with Acute Leukemia. It is a tragic loss for his family, and for Harmony Waitaha. He was a visionary man, who changed our organisation from a single, male chorus to 3 Choruses; The Plainsmen, Quantum Acoustics and OMC, our new "open mixed chorus". His presence is missed already.

I have been singing Baritone with The Plainsmen since 2006. Apart from 5 years away at University in Dunedin, 1 year in Wellington, and 5 years overseas, I have lived in Christchurch.

We are now heading to the Tributaries of He Awa Whiria – the Braided River. Many things are starting to come together in Harmony.

Aaron supported in the pit at the BHA Nationals in 2015 and Pan Pac in 2017, certifying as an ADM judge for AGBJ in the same year. Since certifying, Aaron has been one of the ADM judges for the 2023 Pan Pac, 2024, 2022 and 2018 BHA Nationals as well as several regional contests.

His wide vocal range has helped to propel him into professional entertainment performing at Walt Disney World, Universal Studios, and multiple cruise lines. He is a worship leader at Villagepoint Church and continues to create audio and video content for His World Studios. Currently, Joseph lives in Winter Garden, Florida, with his Dad (Tony), Mom (Jodi), sister (Sophia), and dog (Toby).



Josh Szolomayer - Lead

Josh began his musical journey in Anaheim, California at age 9. Raised in a musical family, he started on piano and added several instruments in his younger years. This led him to pursuing a Vocal Performance degree from Fullerton College in CA. His professional singing career debuted with the Voices of Liberty at Disneyland in 2012. Josh is the owner / operator of Penny Grove Home Solutions LLC, a construction business, specializing in carpentry and home repairs. Josh currently resides in Apopka, Florida with his wife Natalie, and their four children, Alfie (11), Eloise (5), Lola (2), and Georgia (7mo).



Chris Keough - Bass
