#### **FOOD OUTLETS**


The venue itself is not a conventional theatre and does not have in house catering outlets such as a café or other food retailing spaces. We have addressed this by engaging food trucks and coffee carts on site which will be available from about 10:00am through to about 3:30pm.

There are several cafés nearby, the closest, the Craft Café, being immediately outside the Victory Convention Centre, although it is quite small. Further along the road (Beaumont Street) is the Victoria Park Café, and on the opposite corner to that is a New World Supermarket which has an excellent delicatessen that caters for take way lunches and snacks in general.

There are several cafés at the Victoria Park Market, just across Victoria Park. And in the Wynyard Quarter, just across the Motorway, that can be accessed by a footbridge over the Motorway or by going down to Beaumont Street and across a busy intersection.

An additional note: Food and drink is not allowed inside the auditorium. This includes chewing gum, but bottled water is OK. (These rules are only applicable to the auditorium, not the foyer or outside the building.)


#### WHERE TO DINE IN THE EVENING

There are many bars and restaurants in the city. Far too many to list. Again, Google Maps is your friend. But here are some ideas.

The eastern half of Jellicoe Street in the Wynyard Quarter (a 10-minute walk from the Victory Convention Centre) is a fun zone. (It is also where the Viaducts Events Centre is located – the venue for the Saturday Night Afterglow).

Further from the Victory Convention Centre:

- A number of restaurants and bars around the Viaduct Harbour.
- A lively food court at Elliott Stables.
- A number of restaurants around the Britomart area.
